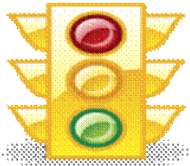

Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability

We have commenced the annual Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability ('the Collection'). This will involve the collection of: the number of students receiving adjustments to enable them to participate in set education on the same basis as other students; the level of adjustment provided to students in our school, and where it is known, the student's type of disability. Under the Collection model the definition of disability is broad and includes learning difficulties, health and mental health conditions. If your child is identified for inclusion in the Collection, the required information about your child will be included in this year's data collection.
