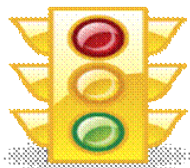

Welcome to Term 4! We are looking forward to a busy and productive term-starting with our annual Book Fair in Week 3. This is always a popular way to encourage your children's reading, to grab a few early Christmas presents, and also to support our library- as we get lots of new books as our reward for the number of books sold. Wellbeing Day Success: We had a highly successful Wellbeing Day in the last week of Term 3. Students learnt lots of new relaxing hobby skills. We had volunteer parents and grandparents sharing a range of skills, and we thank you all for your positive contribution to the day. We also thank our Wellbeing Coordinator, Helen Lister, for the hours of organization to ensure all students experienced a range of activities that supported "having a go" and getting into a state of "flow".

Bushfire season preparation: In line with summer forecasts and our school bushfire Emergency Management Plan, we will be practicing our drills this term and ensuring everyone is aware of their role in the event of a local bushfire. As we communicate with you via text messages when necessary, **please ensure your personal phone numbers are up to date in our records.** This is also the time of year for you to have family discussions to ensure your own family safety plan is well-known to your own children. Children cope better in emergencies (as do we all) when they have a clear idea of what will be done, and why and how. Although we cannot plan for all contingencies, having guidelines prepares us to act quickly and more calmly should we need to, so emergency plans are really invaluable. Our school plan is available on the school website for your information.

Classes for 2018: We are starting to look at the composition of our classes for 2018. As we are not a large school, there are limited options for student class placements, but all requests will be considered and we try to accommodate where possible. Some of our students may have the same teachers for a number of years, as is often the case in smaller schools. Our teachers often work collaboratively and share across classes, so our students get to work with a range of teachers each year. Also remember that some staff are newly appointed and some not yet appointed. **If you have a specific class request please put it in writing to me, explaining reasons for the request, and leave it at the front office in the next fortnight.** I will contact you for any further discussion if necessary, so please include your contact number.
